

Blanket with sleeves

Materials:

3 Yards of fleece 60" wide.

Cut:

Cut 24" off the bottom of fleece.
Divide in half to make two pieces
24" X 30" as shown.
This will make the sleeves.

Fold the large section of fleece in half
lengthwise.
Using the 6" x 9" template measure as
shown in illustration and cut out oval
shapes for sleeve openings.

Sleeves:

Fold the 24" x 30" pieces in half to make
two 12" x 30" tubes. Sew or serge the
long edge. Mark the top of the sleeve by
cutting a small notch.
Finish the cuff edge as desired.
Pin the sleeve into the armhole making sure
to match the notched marks on top and the
seam of the sleeve to the bottom of the
armhole.

Sew or serge seam, and then repeat for other side.

Finish the blanket as desired:

Leave the edges plain since fleece does not ravel.

Fringe the edge using either straight or pinked edges.

Serge the edge using decorative thread or wooley
nylon. (Variegated threads are really nice).

Use a scalloped or other decorative rotary cutter.
